The emerging generation of leaders are working in uncharted waters – that means they need skills and measures of success that exceed any that have gone before them.

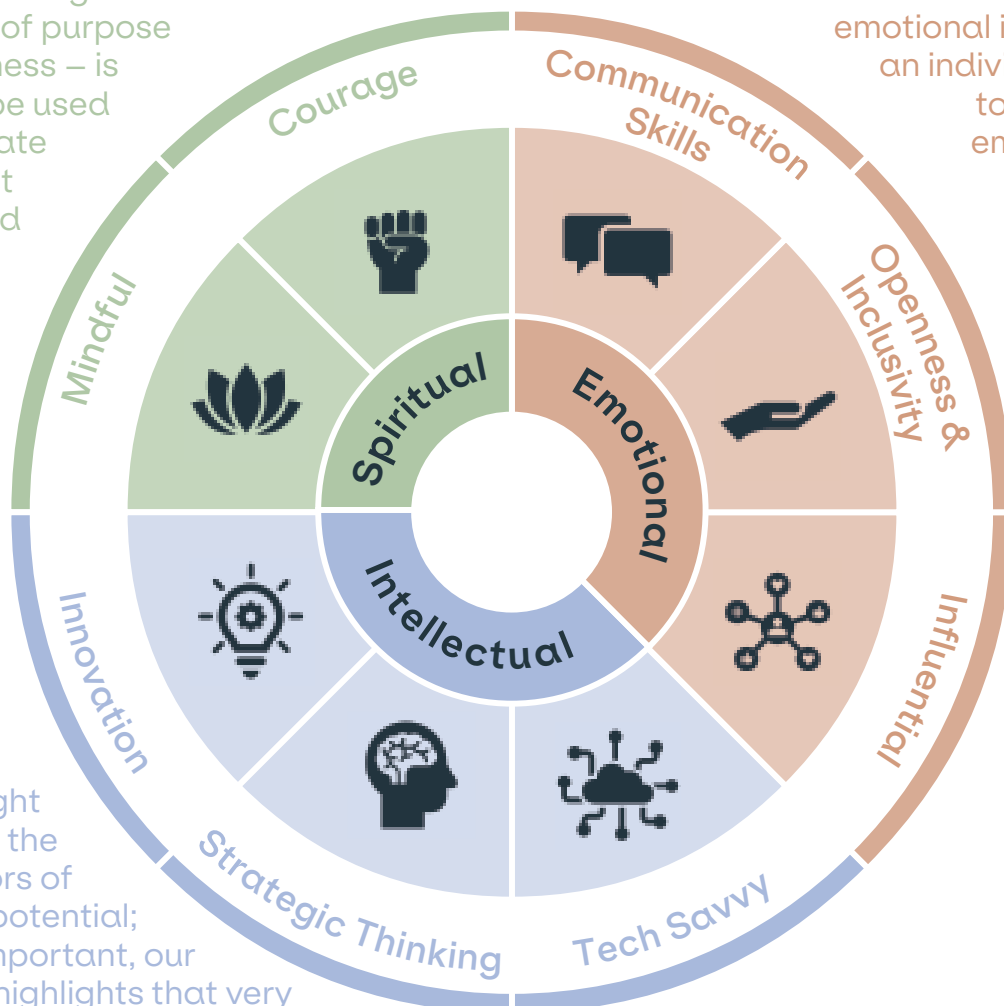
Based on our experience of developing key talents in a wide range of organisations and business contexts, we have identified eight key measures of success for the effective leaders of today AND tomorrow.
